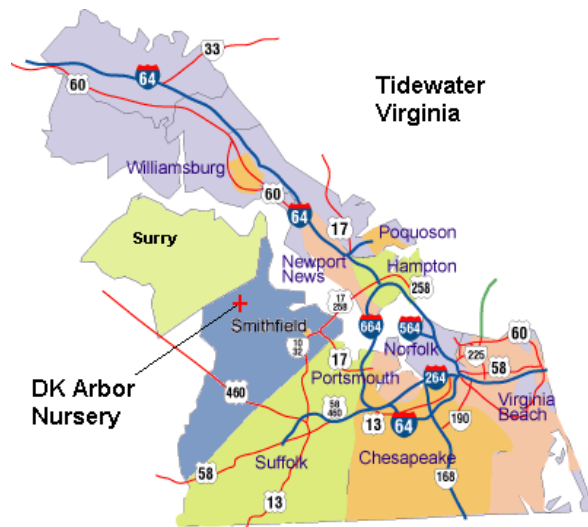

Container stock is grown in Rootmaker® pots which prevent circling roots that often lead to long term damage.

Spring Flowering Shrubs

Aronia arbutifolia 'Brilliantissima'

Excellent shrub border, fast grower, small white flowers in April, red fall foliage and red berries. Full sun or part shade, grows to 8' tall and 5' wide.

Boxwood "Green Velvet" (Buxus x "Green Velvet")

A cross between Korean and A. Boxwood, Green Velvet exhibits handsome, soft, rich new growth and excellent winter color in a compact mounding form.

Awesome winterberry holly grows to 10' with amazing bright red fruit display which persists well into winter. Desiduous.

A compact, small leaf form selected from a group of Mike Dirr's seedlings. Selected for hardiness, compact habit, and heavy orange seed capsules in the fall. May/June. Flowers. (2' x 3')

Radicans

Same great fragrance as larger gardenias, but having a dwarf, rounded form enhanced with petite white flowers and smaller leaves. Excellent in low borders or as a ground cover. Moderate, spreading grower. (1' x 3')

Forsythia x intermedia 'Golden Times'

This forsythia blooms a golden yellow in early spring with upright branching. Variegated foliage.

Pearl-Bush (Exochorda x macrantha 'The Bride')

Here comes 'The Bride'! And she's a beauty. A compact shrub w/ delicate gray-green foliage, which turns yellow and orange in fall, with pearl-like flower buds atop her arching frame in April, she springs into full bloom with 1-2" flowers in May. Heat & drought tolerant. Can be severely pruned for renewal. Soil: Moist but well-drained, acid soil. (3' x 3')

Summer Flowering Shrubs

Butterfly Bush (Buddleia davidii)

This flowering shrub features lilac-like flowers 4" to 10" long from July to frost. It can be very successful in mass plantings (10' x 5')

- Ellen's Blue (Light Blue);
- Guinevere (Blue-Purple);
- Attraction (Red-Purple);
- Black Knight (Dark Purple)

Indigo Plant (Indigofera amblyantha)

A great plant with interesting features. It produces pink flowers from March to mid-October! The profuse flowering over a long period and graceful foliage and habit makes for a wonderful garden addition. Grows to 8' but can be trimmed back for more flowers.

Lantana Camara "Miss Huff"

Tropical appearing shrub, but hardy! Showy clusters of orange and pink flowers through the season. 'Miss Huff' hardy lantana is a small shrub that dies to the ground in winter and is used as a perennial in our area. The key is not to cut its woody stems until early spring. Plant lantana in soil with reasonable drainage (no water saturated winter soils) and mulch. Full sun. Mounded form to 3 to 5 feet tall,

to 10 feet wide.

Beautyberry (Callicarpa dichotoma 'Issai')

An early flowering and fruiting cultivar with small violet fruit in the fall and winter. Grows fast and is trouble free. One of our favorite plants and also a bird favorite! (3' x 3')

Hydrangea, Oak Leaf, Alice (Hydrangea, quercifolia)

Larger habit, foliage, and flower than the species. Fast growing with 1 to 2 foot blooms that change to pink with time. Has replaced the other cultivars as the quercifolia of choice. More heat tolerant than other Oak Leaf. (shrub to 12 feet)

Shade & Flowering Trees

Crapemyrtle, (*Lagerstroemia indica*)

Dynamite Red (Whit II) - This is the first true red tree form crapemyrtle. Cherry red flowers in full sun and hot conditions. (Clouds or shade will reduce red intensity and flecks of white may appear.) New growth is crimson, then green. Upright form to 15 feet. High mildew resistance. **4-6' for \$25.00**



Muskogee (Lavender) - Upright, vase-shaped deciduous tree, Light Lavender, crinkled flowers, Red-orange fall foliage, Attractive accent, massing or border plant, Peeling bark reveals pink inner bark, Dark red/green foliage, 25' Tall X 25' Wide, Full sun, fast growth. **4-6' for \$25.00**

Sarah's Favorite (White) - Fast growing, very cold hardy Crapemyrtle with massive white blooms. Due to cold hardiness, this one leafs out earlier and holds leaves longer in the fall. **6-8' for \$35.00**



Tuscarora (Coral Red) - Another fast growing and vigorous crapemyrtle reaching 25' when mature. Attractive peeling bark. **6-8' for \$35.00**

River Birch (*Betula nigra City Slicker*)

This superior river birch was developed by Dr. Carl Whitcomb as a disease and pest resistant cultivar with beautiful, white, exfoliating bark. Leaves are small and dark green. Estimated mature height is 40-50 feet. We have a limited number of these available in Fall 2008.

Shade & Flowering Trees

Betty Magnolia (*liliflora 'Nigra' x M. stellata 'Rosea'*)

An outstanding new late blooming cultivar developed at the U.S. National Arboretum. Betty has large, abundant, reddish-purple flowers opening before the leaves producing a magnificent display. Foliage remains attractive all season. Betty is a rather erect shrubby grower that will attain a height of 10' and a width of 8'. Plant in full sun to part shade with evenly moist soil.

Dawn Redwood (*Metasequoia glyptostroboides*)

This is just a fantastic tree, if you have room for it to grow. One of my personal favorites. Beautiful exfoliating cinnamon bark, soft almost fern-like needles. Rapid-growing, pyramidal form, deciduous conifer. Grows 80' to 100'.

4Chastetree, (*Vitex agnus-castus 'Shoal Creek'*)
